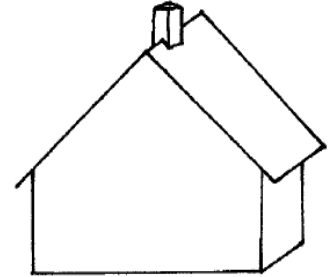




# Gingerbread-By-Design

## Basic Kid-Size Gingerbread House Pattern

This is the most basic Gingerbread House pattern. It is the perfect size for kids, or if you need to make several small houses for Gingerbread House party. A paper plate works well as a base for this Gingerbread House.



### Walls

1. Place four wall pieces (A and B) flat on your base so four corners are touching.
2. Apply a bead of frosting along the base of each piece.
3. Apply a bead of frosting along the sides of each piece.
4. Stand-up each wall, connecting pieces to each other at the sides.

### Roof *(there is no chimney with the kid-size Gingerbread house)*

1. Apply a bead of frosting to top edges of all walls.
2. Attach roof piece C, lining up top edge and peak of house.
3. Hold until set.
4. Attach other roof piece C, lining up top edge and peak of house.
5. Apply frosting down middle of roof line, filling in any gaps in roof.
6. Let dry.
